
Among 16-59 year olds...

6.5% used cannabis

2.2% used powder cocaine

1.5% used ecstasy

0.7% took a new psychoactive substance

Among 16-24s...

1 in 5 used an illicit drug



2.6% took a new psychoactive substance

...in the last year


4.7% of 16-24s are frequent* drug users


3.3% of 16-59s are frequent* drug users


The majority of ecstasy and powder cocaine users take the drug once or twice a year
